## FUTURE ISSUES

*Ecozon@: European Journal of Literature, Culture and Environment* welcomes contributions for future issues. *Ecozon@* is a scholarly journal published by the University of Alcalá and GIECO (Spanish Research Group on Ecocritical Studies) of the Franklin Institute, both of the University of Alcalá, together with EASLCE (European Association for the Study of Literature, Culture and the Environment). Each issue has a general section and a special focus section as well as creative writing, art work and book or film reviews. Each issue of the special focus section will have a specific Call for Papers and a guest editor.

### GENERAL CALL FOR PAPERS:

Submissions must be scholarly articles, exploring the relationship between human beings, culture and the environment. All academic articles are double blind peer reviewed. The proposed essays (6000-8000 words) together with a 250 word (maximum) abstract in the language of the article, as well as in English and Spanish, together with 4-6 keywords in the same languages, must be submitted online following the submission guidelines (free submission) from the website: [www.ecozona.eu](http://www.ecozona.eu). Articles, creative writing and book reviews are accepted in English, Spanish, French, German and Italian. Deadlines for submissions in the general section are January 15th for the autumn issue and July 15th for the spring issue. Every submission must follow the MLA format and the author accepts responsibility for copyright on all materials included in the paper such as images, quotations, etc. See author guidelines for more details.
